BILL McCOLLUM, you have distinguished yourself as a leader in the state and federal government, fighting to protect the citizens of Florida.

You earned your bachelor’s degree and law degree from the University of Florida. After law school, you served on active duty in the United States Navy from 1969 to 1972. In 1992, you retired from the Naval Reserve as a Commander after you served for 23 years as an officer in the Judge Advocate General’s Corps.

From 1981 to 2001, you represented the people of central Florida in the United States Congress. You founded the Congressional Task Force on Terrorism and Unconventional Warfare, and became a nationally recognized expert on terrorism. You also served on the House Judiciary Committee, where you chaired the Subcommittee on Crime, as well as the House Intelligence and Banking committees.

You worked in private practice as a partner with Baker and Hostetler, LLP, until being elected as the Attorney General of Florida in 2006.

As Attorney General, you have led the fight against child pornography and Internet child predators. Your office also works with Florida’s school superintendents on a cybersafety program for Florida’s middle schools and high schools. Also as Attorney General, you continue to develop statewide strategies to address gangs, violent crime and drugs. You work tirelessly to protect the consumer, combat Medicaid fraud, improve the State’s security against terrorist threats, and fight crimes against the elderly.

We at Stetson applaud your many and varied achievements, which have bettered our nation. As evidence of our esteem for you, I am happy to confer upon you, under the authority vested in me by the Stetson University Board of Trustees, the Honorary Doctor of Laws degree, together with all the rights and privileges thereto appertaining, wherever in the world you may go.
